


Canada has managed the COVID crisis relatively well

COVID-19 cumulative deaths per million inhabitants, 7-day moving average






Real GDP, index Q4 2019 = 100




Monthly GDP (volumes) in selected service sectors and whole economy Index, December 2019 = 100

Decline in the rate of employment, January 2020 to January 2021



Fiscal support has been substantial


General government deficit, % of GDP


Gross public debt, % of GDP


Central Banks' total assets


Real house prices, index Q1 2010 = 100


Household indebtedness ratio, % of disposable income 2020 Q3 or latest

Note: High grade: AA AAA, AA, A rated bonds; Low grade: BBB+, BBB, BBB-; Very low grade: BB, B, CCC-D.




Share of households with access to broadband at more than 100 Mbps %, 2018

Insolvency processes can be improved


Scores in selected aspects of insolvency schemes: higher scores indicate worse systems


Greenhouse gas emissions have yet to begin a substantive downward path

Canada has scope to make housing more energy efficient


CO2 emissions from fuel combustion, including electricity and heat, from the residential sector, 2018

Revenues from environmental taxation, as % of GDP 2019 or latest available year





Percentage of 25-64 years old whose social class is higher or lower than that of their parents, 2002-14






Number of long-term care beds in institutions, 2019 or latest

Expenditure on retail pharmaceuticals¹, 2017 or nearest year




Financial disincentive to enter employment with childcare costs, 2019 or latest available


Social rental dwellings, as a % of the total housing stock, 2018 or nearest year
