Department Overview:

Job Description:

This research analyst role will support the ESG research function within TD Economics with a focus on climate policy and social policy. The role requires a highly organized, motivated and team-oriented individual who is able to take ownership of projects, show initiative and creativity, and operate under tight deadlines.

The primary responsibilities include:

- Providing research support to the TD economists involved in environmental and social policy research, including literature reviews, data analysis and management, and compiling charts.
- Providing technical support in developing climate modeling and mapping capabilities for the team
- Providing graphical support to the economists in developing exhibits & infographics, including climate mapping
- Assist with the assembly and distribution of TD Economics research;
- Respond to various internal and external customer requests;
- Perform other duties that may be assigned from time to time by Management.
